PRIMARY PURPOSE

ESSENTIAL DUTIES

- Provide comprehensive, effective, safe care to patients transported by CCT Nurses, Inc.
- Maintain certifications and licenses as mandated by the position
- Maintain clinical skill proficiency and knowledge base
- Complete documentation (written and electronic)
- Maintain positive communication (written and spoken) effectively while interfacing with fellow employees, consortium hospitals, and the community at large
- Stock and clean medical equipment
- Report to remote location(s) for duty
- CCT trip data entry into Excel spreadsheet
- Ability to perform independently within established policies, procedures and standards of practice
- Work collaboratively with EMT's

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- Current California RN License.
- Minimum of two (2) years combined RN experience in a critical care setting (CCU, ICU, ED, CCT)
- Certified in PALS and/or ENPC, BLS and ACLS
- Valid and current California driver's license
- Access to computer with internet access, Microsoft Word and Excel
- Must have a separate part-time or full-time place of employment

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS

- Capable of performing in cramped quarters and any type of weather condition
- Must possess and maintain physical condition which allows walking and carrying of medical equipment and lifting of
 patients
